Applicants must be:<ol style="list-style-type: none">a) QC alumni, orb) children or grand-children of members of QCAA Toronto who, where required, have paid annual dues for the current and 2 preceding financial years.2. Applicants may be residing in any country.3. Applicants must have graduated from their high school (and/or CEGEP in Quebec) with an overall average of 75% in each of their final two (2) years, or with an equivalent high school leaving diploma.4. Applicants must have gained admission to and be about to enter an approved university or college, or already be a student of an approved university or college.5. Applicants must be embarking upon or already participating in a full – time degree/certificate/diploma program for a minimum of one-year's duration.6. Applicants must have demonstrated some involvement in any of the following areas: community leadership, extra-curricular activities, special projects, volunteer service, outside interests or hobbies, career and educational objectives.
Program Administration	The Bursary Fund is administered by the Queen's College of Guyana Alumni Association (Toronto) Inc. A selection is made by a committee appointed by the Executive of the Association, who base their decision on the academic excellence of the student, his/her level of motivation and maturity, community involvement and extra-curricular activities. The Executive of the Association does not participate in the selection of candidates.
Approved Institutions	Any accredited degree or diploma-granting institution as well as Community Colleges

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Payment Award Upon receipt of proof of registration at the approved institution, QCAA Toronto will forward the cheque directly to the recipients.

- Two letters of reference, one from a past teacher and one from a person, other than a relative, who has known the applicant for a minimum of one year.
- Official and up-to-date transcripts covering the final and penultimate years of study. Facsimiles or photocopies are not acceptable.
- Proof of admission (or conditional acceptance) at the approved educational institution.

Application Deadline Completed applications as well as all the supporting documents mentioned above must be sent to the above address postmarked no later than November 30, 2019.

Selection Process Applications will be reviewed by the selection committee appointed by the Executive of the QCAA, its members acting independently. The selection committee will determine from the Secretary of QCAA Toronto if the applicant's parent or grand-parent is in good standing with the Association. Previously successful applicants will not be eligible for future awards under this scheme.

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Decisions of the Committee are final and may not be appealed.

Obligation of
Winner

The recipient must enter or must be already attending the educational institution, on a full-time basis (as defined by the educational institution), in the year of application. If entering the institution for the first time, request for deferment of the award will be considered only in unusual circumstances and the Selection Committee will make the decision.
